

Policy for Free Group Rides following release from Washington State COVID-19 restrictions.

No Pre-Ride Self-Screening Questions are necessary.

In order to be good citizens and protect the health of the community and our riders, the following rules apply on all Free Group Rides:

- All participants must follow State guidance for mask/face-covering use and distancing requirements.
- Unvaccinated riders must follow additional State guidelines for mask/face covering use, such as required mask use while indoors at a stop along the route.
- No spitting or snot-rockets!
- All riders should have masks/face-coverings available for use during the ride. (If a rider has a mechanical problem and needs return transportation, public transit or rideshare services may still require masks.)
- Follow posted social distancing rules at local businesses and public places, such as parks. (Some businesses may still retain their own pandemic rules.)
- Follow local businesses' posted and stated mask rules when indoors.
- Advance online registration is required for all Free Group Rides.

NOTE: "vaccinated" means a person who has received the required regimen of vaccine doses (depending on manufacturer) AND has waited two or more weeks since receiving the final dose of their COVID-19 vaccine. If a person has not received vaccine shots and reached this two-week milestone, they are considered "unvaccinated." Those persons who have not yet completed their full shot and wait regimen (not yet fully vaccinated) are also considered "unvaccinated" and they should follow the "unvaccinated" guidelines.
