

# Instructions for using the timing chip for one day riders.

If the timing chip is not placed as diagramed below the system will not be able to read your chip and you will not have a finishing time. Your time starts when you go under the start line banner on Saturday and ends when you go under the finish line banner by 9 p.m. the same day. If you miss either location you will not have a total time.

Install timing chip on top of your helmet with 4 sets of Velcro dots. If the Velcro dots will not work on your helmet then you can use tape, rubber bands or any other none metallic material. Note that the number on the timing chip is NOT the same as your STP rider bib number.

## Installation Instructions:

1. You should have a timing tag and a set of 4 Velcro dots (4 white & 4 black).
2. Pick the location for your helmet based on the vents by holding the tag over your helmet before applying the Velcro dots. Apply the Velcro dots to the side of the tag that has the BLUE marks (non-metallic side). Avoid placing dots over any stickers. The metalic tag needs to be on the top of your helmet.
3. Place 4 black Velcro hook dots along the top of your helmet.
4. Place the other 4 white Velcro loop dots on the black dots and remove the adhesive backs.
5. Press timing tag down firmly and you are done.

## How the timing works

1. You **MUST** go under the start line banner in Seattle. You can start at any time from 4:45 to 7:30 a.m.
2. Ride the STP in one day and go under finish line banner before Saturday, 9 p.m.
3. Return your timing chip at the finish line in the buckets at the end of ths shoot or at the green Cascade Bicycle Club tent in the merchandise area.
4. When you finish times will be posted live at [www.turboreg.net](http://www.turboreg.net). Post event times will be posted on the cascade.org/stp web site within 2 days.
